## 2020 Accomplishments

- Made emergency grants to the Library for digital materials and laptops for checkout thanks to incredible financial support from the community to provide this extra pandemic relief!
- **Increased Library Funding**: successfully advocated the Mayor and Assembly Members to increase the Library's budget for 2021: added an Early Literacy Outreach Librarian, additional tech support and funding for the Community Resource Coordinators.
- Launched a campaign for a New Alaska Room at Loussac Library: secured a \$390K challenge grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities one of only 30 projects awarded.
- STEM Kits: added 66 STEM Kits to the Library's collection of science activities for checkout.
- Launched the Next Chapter Society: two new members joined the eleven founding members who have designated the Library Foundation in their will or retirement plans.
- Funded an Assistant Library Community Resource Coordinator to serve the Mountain View Library, and a peer navigator program (to launch in 2021).
- **Upgraded furniture and signage at libraries**: including family reading area at Loussac, a reading nook at Gerish Girwood, new signs at Chugiak-Eagle River and a study bar at Mountain View.

## 2021 Projects

- Alaska Room at Loussac Library: host a community design process to get input on final designs, and raise funds to start the project by 2023.
- Express Libraries: help the Library open a new express location at the Dimond Transit Center.
- **Digital Resources for Students**: renew BookFlix and other Library resources that have been critical for our young students during COVID.
- **Equity, Diversity and Inclusion**: support the Library's work to be a more equitable and inclusive organization, as well as update the Library Foundation's own policies and practices.
- The Next Chapter Society: share information on how to leave a legacy by making gifts through wills and retirement plans, as well as offer workshops on wills and estate planning.
- **Library Promotion:** continue to grant marketing funds to the Library to help it increase its visibility in the community and promote its valuable resources.
- **Respond to Urgent Needs**: provide funding for the Library to take advantage of new opportunities and fill budget gaps so that our Library can continue to offer top-notch service.
